Jonathan Ullman is President & CEO of The Mob Museum, the National Museum of Organized Crime and Law Enforcement. The Mob Museum is a 501(c)3 nonprofit located in downtown Las Vegas, with a mission of advancing the public understanding of organized crime's history and impact on society. Reporting to a 22-member Board of Directors, Jonathan is responsible for leading the organization that has The Mob Museum been named both a "Top Workplace" and "Best Museum" by the Las Vegas Review Journal and ranked #20 on TripAdvisor's list of top museums in the United States.

Jonathan has spent over 20 years in a variety of management and leadership roles within the nonprofit industry. Jonathan's museum career began at Liberty Science Center, New Jersey's most visited museum, where he was intimately involved in the strategic planning and operationalizing of the facility following a \$109 million capital expansion. Over the years, Jonathan served in numerous capacities with responsibilities including intensive staff management, program oversight, and external relations. Immediately prior to joining The Mob Museum, Jonathan was the president and COO at the National Soccer Hall of Fame, where he led the dramatic transformation of the organization's operating model.

Jonathan earned his Bachelor's Degree from Rutgers College and his Masters of Business Administration from Rutgers Business School. A believer in the importance of community, Jonathan has volunteered on a number of nonprofit boards and community-driven initiatives. Jonathan currently serves as Chairperson of the Downtown Las Vegas Alliance. He is a graduating member of the LV Metro Police Department Citizens' Academy and the FBI Citizens' Academy, now serving as the President of the FBI Citizens' Academy Alumni Association. Additionally, Jonathan is a graduate of the Las Vegas Metro Chamber of Commerce's Leadership Las Vegas program and a past Curriculum Chair. Jonathan resides in Las Vegas with his wife and three children.

Ted Whiting
“Cheating in Las Vegas”

Ted Whiting has been employed in the Gaming industry since 1989. Early in his career he held various casino positions such as Dealer, Cage Cashier, and Poker Room Brush. From 1995 until 2009, Mr. Whiting worked in The Mirage Resort and Casino Surveillance room and was promoted to Director of Surveillance in 2001. Starting in 2006, Ted worked on creating the casino surveillance system at the multi-billion dollar Resort and Casino project known as City Center. Ted became the director of Surveillance for City Center’s Aria Resort and Casino in 2009. In February 2015, he was promoted to his current position as Vice-President of Corporate Surveillance at MGM Resorts International in which he oversees all surveillance at 12 properties in Las Vegas, Maryland and Massachusetts.

“CHIPOLGY 101”

Dick Covington and Michael Knapp created Chipology 101 in 2000 to explain visually many of the terms, features and distinctions of casino chips. For example, how do foreign chips differ from US chips? What’s a jeton? What’s the difference between antique chips and modern chips? What does variety or variation mean? Whaddaya mean, there’s stuff on a chip that I can’t see?! Chipology 101 is a seminar for new – and not so new – chippers. Chances are, everyone will learn something!

Dick Covington started collecting in 1992 and is a Lifetime Member. He is one of the original members of and is currently serving on the Standards and Archive Committee, Co-Chair of the club Auction (producing the Multi-media Auction presentation used during the Auction so that the audience can see the item(s) in the respective Lots with the bids from the Auction Floor shown live. Dick’s graphic skills have also been used in the update of the Club Logo, creating live casino chips for play at multiple casinos; convention program and auction covers; banquet dinner tickets; NCV chips used at both the conventions at the Orleans and the club logo for the Premium Tokens. Dick has also served as Convention Photographer/Co-Photographer since conventions at the Aladdin.

Michael Knapp is an original Charter Member of the Club and served as its Secretary for its first 13 years. He is a member of the Hall of Fame and is an Honorary Life Member. He has served as Convention Co-Chairman, Educational Director, and Chairs the Standards and Archives Committee. “The Mental Game: Learning To Relax In Order To Win”

Brenda Riemer will be discussing a few mental skills that people can practice in order to reduce anxiety and stress. The philosophy behind a mental skills seminar is the fact that people are not born with perfect mental skills for competition (and life events). George Steel is a retired Detroit attorney and a long-time member (R-361) of our club. As a life long Michigan resident and a casino history enthusiast he is very familiar with the inception and development of Detroit casinos. He has represented casinos in litigation and has had professional relationships with members of the Michigan Gaming Control Board.

At our 2019 convention George shall present “A Study of Detroit Casinos”, an informative and entertaining perspective of the prelude and evolution of modern Detroit gaming.

BLACKJACK & POKER TOURNAMENTS

Both the Blackjack Tournament and the Gene Trimble Memorial Poker Tournament will be held at the South Point in their respective locations on the casino floor and poker room during the CCA Annual Convention. The Tournaments are open to current CCA regular, life and associate members only (age 21+). Daily Convention Membership does NOT qualify for entry in the tournaments. Both Tournaments require a minimum number of entries. Full tournament rules will be available at the Tournaments.

The Blackjack Tournament will begin at 9:00 PM on Wednesday, June 19th.

The entry fee is \$70 per player. Each player receives 3,000 in NCV tournament chips each round. The bet limits are: 25 minimum/3000 maximum. A maximum of 54 players will be accepted and we anticipate that there will be three (3) preliminary rounds, followed by one semi-final round, finishing with one final round. Players will be scheduled to play in one of the preliminary rounds (9:00 pm, 10:00 pm or 11:00 pm). If a player does not advance to the semi-final round, re-entries into a later initial round will be accepted (if space is available) at \$70 per re-entry. The 11:00 pm round may be canceled, if warranted. Final round players win a portion of the net prize pool, which is dependent upon the number of players.

The Gene Trimble Memorial Poker Tournament will be held on Friday, June 21st starting at 7:00 PM. Walk-ins and sign-ups starting at 6:00 PM.

The entry fee is \$90 per player. Each player receives 5,000 in NCV tournament chips. The format will be no limit Texas Hold'em. Blinds start at 25-25 and limits and antes increase each period of play. Minimum bet and raise increments are equal to the big blind, unless all-in. If seats for the Poker Challenge are still available, Players can sign up at the convention; but, as always, it's on a first-come, first-served basis. Tables will be consolidated periodically throughout the Tournament. Finalists will be paid in the order of finish, based on the number of players.

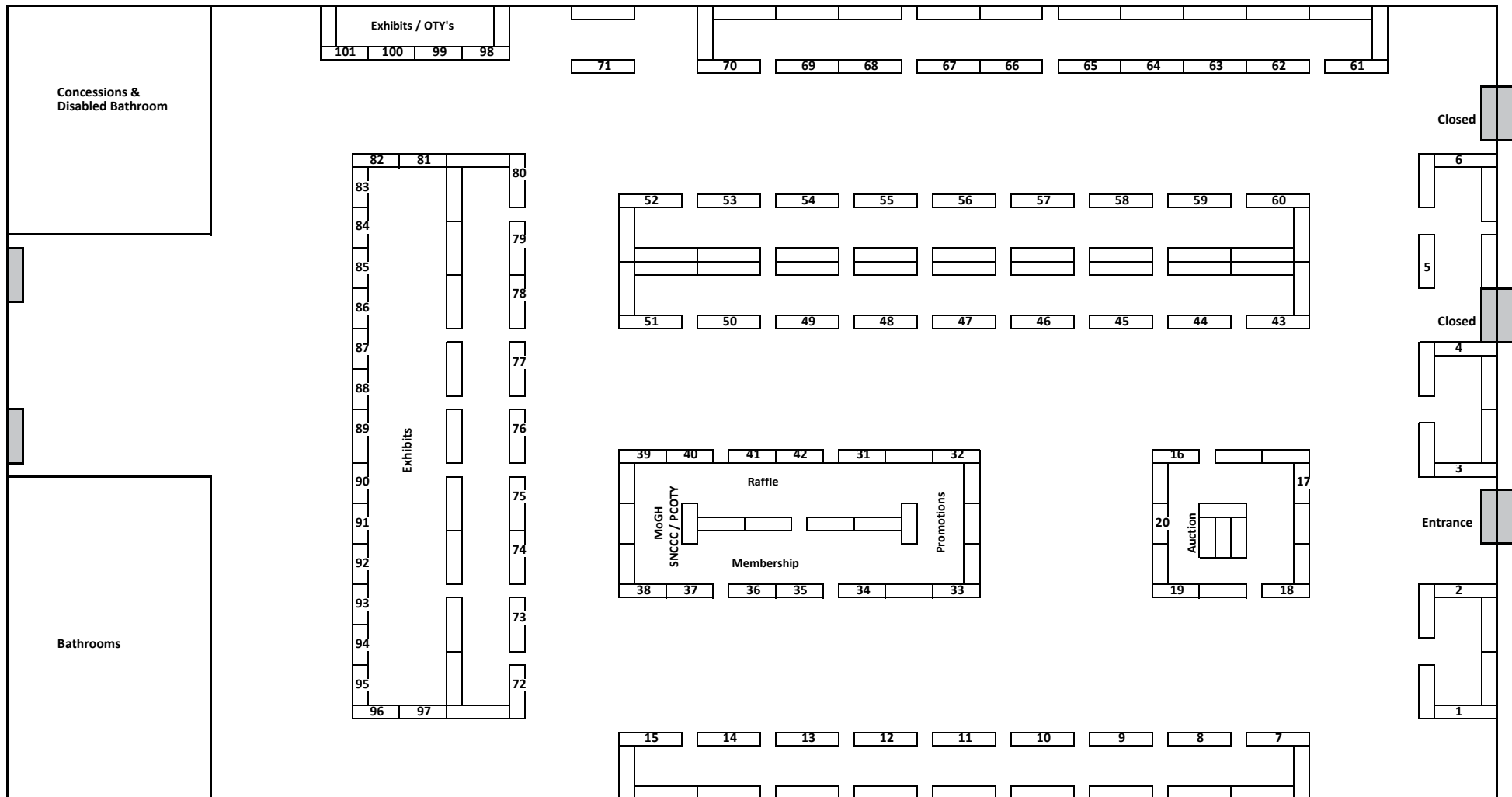
