

## 2021 CCA ELECTION RESULTS

18 valid nomination forms were received; none were voided.

One member received one nomination for President and three members received one nomination for Secretary. Per the CCA Constitution, a member must receive two nominations to be eligible to run for Office.

The following members received a minimum of two nominations from current CCA members, per the requirements, for the CCA Board of Directors' positions shown.

President: Steve Bedo / Mark Lighterman / Jerry Vergatos

Secretary: Rich Huber / David Spragg

- Steve Bedo declined the nomination for President.
- Mark Lighterman and Jerry Vergatos accepted their nominations for President.
- Rich Huber and David Spragg accepted their nominations for Secretary. Rich Huber withdrew from the election at a later date, so David Spragg was unopposed for the Secretary position.

The CCA Constitution requires a 2/3 majority of votes cast to amend it. The above Constitution Amendment passes with 95.8% of votes cast.

Congratulations to Jerry Vergatos and David Spragg. The term for the Office of President and Secretary will be two years (2021 - 2023).

The ballots received represent 24%% of the total CCA membership of 1,031 as of 4/8/21.

At the annual CCA business meeting on June 19, 2021, we, the Election Co-Chairmen, will report the election results which will then be certified, at the meeting, by a vote of the current Officers and Board of Directors.
