

Annual OTY Awards are now open to Candidate submissions.

Unless you are very, very new to the Club, then you already know that as we "Welcome in the New Year", we also kickoff the OTY Awards.

While the New Year is focused on 2023, the OTY Awards will focus on 2022. This year will mark the 32nd OTY Awards Contest, which began in 1991 for 1990 issued Chips and Gaming Tokens, as Chip of the Year (COTY) and Token of the Year (TOTY). Over time, Silver Strikes were added as a separate category as Silver Strike of the Year (SSOTY) and later still, Slot Cards and Room Keys were added as a combined category for Slot Card/Room Key of the Year (CKOTY). With the advent of Ticket-In/Ticket-Out (TITOs) the minting of slot machine tokens have all but disappeared, so TOTY Awards have been put on hiatus, pending the issue of 5 or more unique slot machine tokens in a given year.

The OTY Awards are managed by Trey Warren, as the OTY Awards Director, following the services of Jim Follis and Archie Black in that role over the years. This post includes a link and image of the 2022 OTY Awards Nomination Form, which may be used by any CCA Member in good standing to nominate from 1 - 3 candidates for OTY consideration in 3 categories, COTY, SSOTY and CKOTY.

Submitters are NOT required to provide a candidate for each category, nor the maximum number of candidates per each category, however, the greater number of nominees the greater the diversity when the contest moves from Nominations to Balloting.

Well, those are the basics, but for greater details, please see the fine print below.

The fine print, by Trey Warren...

Greetings Fellow CCA'ers,

The time has come to start the countdown to our 2022 annual convention! I am officially opening our CCA OTY nomination period and I will start collecting nominations for your favorite casino collectibles released in 2022!

We have 3 active categories of casino collectibles that you may nominate for the 2022 CCA OTY Awards:

- 1. Chip of the Year (COTY).
- 2. CCA Silver Strike of the Year (SSOTY*).
- 3. Slot Card/Room Key of the Year (CKOTY).

Here are our 2022 nomination rules:

- To submit CCA OTY nominations, you must be an active CCA member in good standing.
- Your choices for nominations must have been released in a casino in the year 2021 to be eligible for the contest.
- Nominations are now limited to 3 eligible casino items per category. You may nominate less if you wish.
- Nominations must be received by the deadline to be counted, prior to midnight (CST) February 28th, 2022.
- *As a point of clarification, this is the CCA Silver Strike contest. There is a separate annual award contest held by the Silver Striker's Club which often causes some confusion. I am a member of both clubs, if you enjoy collecting Silver Strikes and are not a current club member, I encourage you to consider joining the Silver Striker's Club. You can find additional information or complete a membership application on Silverstrikers.com if you are interested in exploring membership.

- Due to a lack of physical ballots received for the 2018 contest, we discontinued physical ballots in 2019, we will continue to take all nominations through email only. If you would like to submit a nomination and do not have access to email, please reach out to a fellow CCA Member that can submit your nominations on your behalf.
- Any items that were not released in 2022 will not be considered and will have to be resubmitted for consideration for next year's contest.
- After the nomination period has closed, I will publish our finalists in March, along with details on our voting process to choose the final winners that will be announced in June at the 2023 CCA convention.

If you need help reviewing options to choose your nominees, here are some helpful tips on locating images of chips, silver strikes, room keys, & player's cards that were released during 2021:

To look at 2022 COTY casino chip options:

- 1. Go to the The ChipGuide. (www.chipguide.com).
- 2. Click "ChipGuide Query Facility" from the options under the "Features" section on the left side of the page.
- 3. In the filter section, for Casino Status, select "Open". There are 2 filters that you will need to check, for Collectible Type, choose "Table Chips", the Date Range needs to be "Equal", and finally type "2022" in the Date 1 section. Then click "Query". After you review the options presented from your first search, you will need change the Collectible Type filter to "Limited Edition Chips" and click "Query" again to see the remaining nomination options.
- Take note of the "Issued" date to make sure your choice is eligible.

To review eligible 2022 SSOTY silver strikes nominees, access each of the following links online:

Links to view 2022 issued Silver Strikes are being developed as of press time and will be posted here when available.

To browse player's cards/rooms keys that were released in 2022:

- 1. Go to the The ChipGuide. (www.chipguide.com).
- 2. Click "ChipGuide Query Facility" from the options under the "Features" section on the left side of the page.
- 3. In the filter section, for Casino Status, select "Open". There are 2 filters that you will need to check, for Collectible Type, choose "Player's Club (Slot) Cards", the Date Range needs to be "Equal", and finally type "2022" in the Date 1

section. Then click "Query". After you review the options presented from your first search, you will need change the Collectible Type filter to "Room Keys" and click "Query" again to see the remaining nomination options.

• Again, please reference the "Issued" date to confirm nomination eligibility.

Credit for these images go to our fellow collectors that are members of both the CCA and Silver Striker's Club that love our hobby and kindly submitted them to both the Chip Guide & to the Silver Striker's Club for posting on the websites. Since both websites rely our fellow collectors for image submissions, every piece released in 2022 may not be represented at this time. If you notice that a favorite item of yours that was released in a casino in 2022 is missing from any of the search queries, you are still welcome to nominate the piece for the 2022 CCA OTY Awards contest. Please send a scan of missing item when you submit your completed nomination form for eligibility verification.

When you submit your 2022 CCA OTY nominations be sure to include the following information:

- Your name & CCA Member number.
- For each nominated item, please specify the category (COTY, SSOTY, CKOTY), the casino name, the denomination (if it applies), a description, the city/locale, & the state/country that the nominee was released in.
- An image of each nominated item if available.

I hope that all CCA members will have fun and send in a few nominations for the 2022 contest! Please stay tuned for additional 2022 CCA OTY Award updates in our newsletter, future issues of the CCA Casino Collectible News, and on our chat boards as well.

Cheater Devices Exhibit has been retired.

Sadly, the MoGH's Agreement with the Nevada State Museum and Nevada Gaming Control, has come to a conclusion, after 3 years. Originally set for 12 months, both the Museum and Gaming agreed to 2, 12 month extensions, which expired at the end of December, 2022.

After the logistics to remove the Exhibit were arranged, MoGH Board members Ted Whiting and Jim Follis de-installed the Exhibit on January 31st, 2023. In attendance were 2 representatives from

the Las Vegas Review and Journal newspaper, as part of a future, series of articles being developed by the newspaper about Gaming Control's Black Book. Both a seasoned reporter and photographer were present to take pictures of the devices and interview both Ted and Jim. A publication date has not yet been set

Speaking of MoGH Board member Ted Whiting, Ted has created a unique fund raising activity for the MoGH. Ted is an avivd reader and gaming historian buff and has offered a unique opportunity to the MoGH. Ted finds old, out-of-print gambling related books that have also transitioned into the Public Domain. Ted, gives these finds a new cover design, reprints them in their entirety, and makes them available on Amazon. Charles Kaplan has modified the MoGH's ChipGuide site to sporadically display a green colored banner ad that shows several available titles.

Clicking the titles will take a viewer to Amazon to see additional book details and make a purchase. 50% of the purchase price goes to the MoGH and the remainder to Ted, but he pays for publication and shipping costs out of his portion.

To facilitate payment options, the CCA's Treasurer has set-up a Zelle account to transfer funds for these purchases. Thank you Ted Whiting for this novel approach to MoGH Fundraising.
