CCA Board Actions through February, 2020

Publicity Budget

Publicity Chairman, Rich Burgel, presented, for the upcoming Convention in June. Many existing programs were presented as well as new events to be implemented. Discussion followed and questions were discussed with more clarification needed from the Chairman. Request for additional information was forwarded for consideration

Action: Proposal tabled pending response by Publicity Chairman.

<u>MoGH</u>

For reference purposes, Sandra Harris
Agreements, were discussed and entered in to the record.

Action: None taken for discussion only.

Eric S. Rosenblum Estate

Michael Sisken, CCA Legal Committee member, presented an agreement in the settlement of the Rosenblum estate. The CCA, as a 'contingent beneficiary', has agreed to the settlement in the legal matter and President Vergatos has been authorized to sign the agreement.

Action: Non needed Announcement only.

Membership, Privacy

Roy Nelson, Membership Director, requested clarification on the CCA's Privacy Policy concerning the granting of request for our Membership Directory by Club members only. The Board has decided that only, Name and physical addresses would be given out. Do Not Publish (DNP) names, address's and e-mail

addresses, would not be included.

Action: Approved, Unanimous.

Membership, Payments

Roy Nelson requested discussion on offering a multiyear payment plan for Life Memberships. Discussion followed and it was determined that it was not feasible to offer payments as it would create confusion and an accounting scenario which would be too cumbersome.

Action: Not Approved, Unanimous.

Hall Of Fame

Roy Nelson, a member of the CCA Hall of Fame, brought forward from the Hall of Fame Committee, for discussion by the CCA Board, the topic of allowing deceased members, who were pioneers in the chip collecting hobby, to be honored in a new category of recognition. Some discussion ended with the CCA BOD determining that the Hall of Fame Members should decide amongst themselves who would be worthy of such recognition.

Action: Approved, Unanimous.

Donations

Roy Nelson brought up the discussion of certain donations made to the Club by members, designated to be used for membership. A limited discussion was conducted and the decision to hold the donation for 2 years so as not to affect the value of the donation.

Action: Approved Unanimous.

Life Member Pins

New Life Member pins will be ordered with the

newer CCA logo. Only new Life Members will receive the updated pins. Current members wishing to purchase the new pins may do so at a cost of \$5.00.

Action: Approved Unanimous.

Donation Letters

A proposal was brought forward concerning the documentation of donations and the process by which we accept them and actions that we may take with those donations. A formal letter is to be drawn up with guidance and recommendations from outside museum administrations. The Mob Museum has offered to share their 3 forms of Donation acceptance.

Action: Tabled Pending inspection of Documents.

MoGH

MoGH Chairman, Mike Quinlivan, has presented a proposal by which any sitting CCA President should be able to vote on any and all MoGH issues and be able to abstain if any of those issues would require subsequent CCA Board member voting, if they so happen to be on both the MoGH BoD and The CCA BoD.

Action: Approved Unanimous.

Membership, Rejoining

Request was made by a Club Member that they would like to have their original membership number reinstated if their membership has lapsed and they wish to rejoin. The official policy is that this would be granted if the member was willing to

pay for all the dues of the lapsed years. Member was notified by Roy Nelson

Action: None Needed Clarification of Existing Policy.

Ivory Poker Chips

A current member brought up concern about the Clubs policy on Buying/Selling/Trading of antique ivory chips. Some selling sites have banned the sale of such items. The Club does not have a policy on this endeavor and so the member is free to conduct their business as they see fit.

Action: Approved Unanimous.

PAST ISSUES OF CCN

Ed Hertel has presented a request that all articles be posted on our website as it would be a great resource and excellent way to promote the relevance of our Club. The addition of past articles has been slow and very much needed. Board Member David Spragg has agreed to update the articles that have been lacking up to 2 years from the present date.

Action: Approved Unanimous.

CCA Website Revision

A proposed web site revision was shown and discussed by BoD members . Suggestions and directives to move forward were discussed with David Spragg, CCA Webmaster. He will be proceeding to connect the various links from the existing site to the new site. A possible launching of the new site could be within 3 months.

The Silver Strike program dwindled all the way down to just two casinos left with any silver strike machines in 2018. The Four Queens Casino and the El Cortez

Casino. While the El Cortez is down to one machine, Shaun Webster (Director, Four Queens Slots) has been busy adding more machines to his inventory and even added one that would allow you to win a \$40 Strike.

Since that period in 2018, we have turned the corner, while ever so slightly, it is a sign hopefully that more will follow. The Route 66 Casino in Albuquerque, New Mexico started that turn by installing two machines in the summer of 2019 and issuing four clad designs. In October 2019 a coloured strike of one of the designs was released in a blue capsule.

Silver Strikers were once again rewarded with the Plaza Casino coming on board in January 2020. The Plaza also installed two machines and released 4 clad designs.

I do hope that the Route 66 and the Plaza Casinos will consider adding more coloured strikes and also some red cap .999 silver strikes like the old days.

I asked Jonathan if he was looking to expand the program by offering blue cap colored and red cap silvers. I pointed out that by offering these limited edition strikes among the regular clad strikes, people would play to win one of these limited-edition strikes. It was something he would definitely look into going forward.

Another important question that I asked was if the Plaza would redeem the older strikes at the cage and then put them back into the machine among the new clad strikes. Jonathan did not know if that was happening but was eager to find out and see if it could happen. Jonathan was happy to hear that one of the older Plaza silver strikes has been nominated for the 2019 Hall of Fame!!
