Hall of Fame

Proposal to purchase at an upcoming auction, a chip, once possibly owned by Howard Hughes from his personal collection. Matter discussed

Action: Declined Unanimous

Acceptable Use Policy

Membership Director, Roy Nelson, presented a new policy to clarify the availability and use of allowing members access to the Membership Directory.

Action: Approved Unanimously

Web Revision

Membership Directory, Acceptable Use Policy

For the purpose of maintaining an accurate and up-to-date membership roster, the CCA collects and retains member names, mailing addresses, email addresses, phone numbers, membership numbers, dates joined, valid through dates, "Do Not Publish" (DNP) status, and other similar data, into a digital database. In order to protect the privacy of our members, the following guidelines are adopted as CCA Board Policy, as they relate to requests by CCA Members for a Membership Directory.

A **full** membership directory will be provided when a member's request is for a CCA business-related purpose.

Examples: To verify membership for voting (CCA Officer and Constitutional Elections), OTY Awards nominations and balloting, Hall of Fame recommendation submittals, and the like.

To provide follow up contact information for a CCA sponsored events, such as the Convention Raffle, Auctions, fundraisers, etc.

A **partial** membership directory (members name and mailing address only) may be provided to a CCA member, when the request is not for a CCA sponsored event or official use. Whenever a digital version is provided, care is taken to only include the data noted, i.e. name and mailing address. Moreover, DNPs, as noted below, will not be included in the Directory provided.

Examples: To aid in the advertising an upcoming chip show, local clubs meetings and the like.

When a full or partial membership directory is provided, it shall be marked, across the top of each page, that it has 'DO NOT PUBLISH' ("DPNs" as noted below) information.

The CCA provides members the opportunity to indicate 'Do Not Publish' (DNP) along with their membership and these members will have their information provided only when the request is CCA business-related. The DNP designation is done at the time of application for membership and can be added or deleted at any time by notifying the CCA Membership Officer.



Thank you Steve, a most excellent report, but before I get to an update on the Legendary Stardust Project, we need to add your omitted Item "C"....

C. A big <u>CONGRATULATIONS</u> to Steven Palumbo on being selected as the new MoGH Chairman. Way to go Steve!

And now, the latest on the Legendary Stardust Project, especially now that we are at liberty to disclose the full nature of this Project.

About a year ago, I was contacted by a Boyd Gaming vendor, asking if I was familiar with the concept of "Pop-Up Museums"? I had to say that I needed to Google it, but after a few hits, I had the general idea, which is to

temporarily, put up an easily transported display, that can pop-up here today and somewhere else tomorrow. We began discussions wherein the MoGH would support a traveling museum, in tribute to the Legendary Stardust, as well as setting up fixed displays at 7 Las Vegas area Boyd Gaming properties, and Boyd Gaming's Corporate Headquarters location also here in Las Vegas.

At the time, Boyd Gaming was beginning their transition to Aristocrat's casino management software programming, which included a complete revamping of Boyd Gaming's "B-Connected" Player Rewards Program. Moreover, the Aristocrat product also offered a social gaming platform, which could be integrated into Boyd's "B-Connected" Rewards Program, as well as Facebook and other "social" media platforms.

Initially, the roll-out of that social media product, called "Stardust Social Casino" was to be enhanced at the Las Vegas Boyd properties with MoGH display cabinets, using content loaned and donated from or membership and others.

But enter COVID-19....

March of 2020 was one of the target dates, but the closure of casinos State-wide in Nevada, put a delay on that. With the casinos re-opening here Las Vegas in June, we had hoped for better developments. Unfortunately, CDC recommendations against group gatherings and social distancing, it would be contrary to setting up displays where the intent is to draw viewership with people standing shoulder-to-shoulder. And we are again, on hold for the displays for the displays.


However, since Boyd's overall effort is geared for online engagements, a website is being developed to promote the Stardust Social Casino and parts of that development includes creating content with videos, images, and sorts of digital media related 'stuff' and The MoGH will shortly be signing an Agreement to provide tourist taken photographs of the Stardust, over the years, for which the MoGH has obtained approval to use in this manner.

So, in short, the MoGH is still on-hold for our need for Stardust material in the form of loans or donations, and we are actively seeking tourist taken

pictures of the Stardust, where we can obtain owner permission to use the images.

The MoGH's website will host all such images, with ownership credit being giving for each image. When provided to Boyd Gaming, credit will be given to The MoGH, where possible, in name or via the MoGH's logo. Moreover, where possible, a hot-link to The MoGH will also be added.






