





Greetings from Almost Alive,

Well, it's been a couple of months now and, although we are nowhere near what we used to call "normal", we seem to be headed in the right direction.

"Special thanks" to the member who pointed out to me that I completely forgot to remind everyone that club dues were due. Since most members usually pay at the convention, and since there was no convention this year, I totally FORGOT!! Any who, I figure that since almost everything that has to do with our collecting has been shut down for the past 4-5 months, I would extend memberships through to the end of 2020. Paying your dues now will take you through to the end of 2021. Also, as you will notice, this is a much shorter newsletter, since everything was closed for most of March, April, May and June.

As far as I can tell, PLANET HOLLYWOOD, TROPICANA, LUXOR, TEXAS STATION, both FIESTAS and the PALMS, are the only casinos that are still closed. BALLY'S just opened on 7/23. COLORADO BELLE (Laughlin, NV) - has closed permanently, effective immediately. GOLDEN NUGGET - Announced that it has permanently closed its buffet. TREASURE ISLAND - Also permanently closed its buffet. STATIONS CASINOS - Currently in Phase 2, and have announced that "Phase 3" is on hold. Phase 1 was - Boulder Station, Green Valley Ranch, Palace Station, Santa Fe Station and Sunset Station casinos. Phase 2 was - All Wildfire neighborhood casinos. Phase 3 would have been -Palms, Texas Station and both Fiesta casinos.

TWIN RIVER HOLDINGS (Rhode Island) has announced that it has agreed to purchase the ELDORADO (Shreveport, LA), and MONTBLEU (Lake Tahoe, NV), from Eldorado Resort Holdings, and BALLY'S (Atlantic City, NJ) from Caesars Entertainment. Announced purchase price of the 3 casinos was given as \$185 million.

The Eldorado Resort Holdings buyout of Caesars Entertainment has been approved by the New Jersey Casino Control Commission. This was the final approval needed to complete Eldorado's \$17.3 billion buyout of Caesars. This gives Eldorado Resorts control of over 50 casinos in the US, UK, Egypt and Canada, and a golf course in Macau.


