From the CCA Board of Directors...

As was published in the March, 2021 CCA Newsletter and on the CCA's Message Board, it has been decided to go forward with planning the CCA's 2021 Convention and Show at the South Point Hotel Casino Spa, for (16*) and 17 - 19 June, 2021.

This decision was made based on several considerations, including National and Nevada Governmental COVID Guidance, South Point requirements, responses to the CCA's Dealer and Attendee Questionnaires, and will be further evaluated due to anticipated evolving Governmental directions. In Nevada, the Governor has announced that, given the current downward direction of COVID conditions, the State plans to shift the responsibility of Governmental Health and Safety COVID policy, from the State, to local municipalities in April.

At the present time, Nevada has a mandatory mask requirement, and we find that this mandate is exceptionally enforced in most casino environments. This is because the Gaming Control Board has extended it's authority to enforcement of this requirement and several casinos have had to pay very heavy monetary penalties for lack of enforcement. Accordingly, things could change, but the CCA Board is confident that we can move forward with Convention planning. Accordingly, the following information is provided. 



This year's convention is hopefully only a few short months away if we are able to have it. We are in continued contact with South Point and the Governor's Office. For those not from Nevada, or not following Nevada's Covid response activities, as directed by the Governor this is where we are at: currently, the state's Covid cases are ebbing down as of February 15th most indoor businesses can now operate at 35% capacity, dine-in restaurants are now allowing parties of six. If trends continue the plan is to increase capacity to 50%. Large group activities are currently set at 50 people. Again, if trends continue the numbers for activities will increase. While this paints a positive picture for our convention there are no guarantees that things may change.
