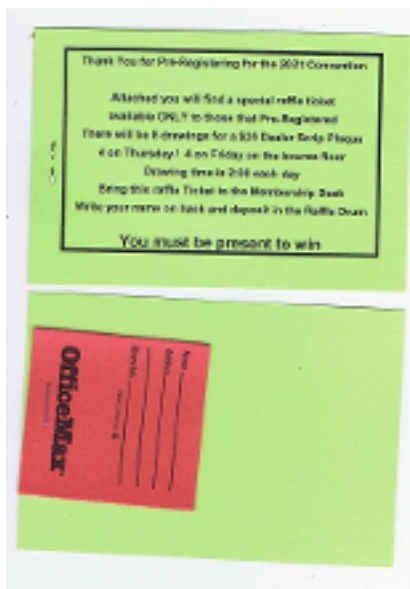

# A WELCOME to our newest CCA Life Members from Roy Nelson, CCA Membership Officer...

Any Club member interested in becoming a Life Member, should note the following qualifications as excerpted from the Club's Constitution:

E. Life Members: members in good standing **age 25 or older** who apply, after completion of their third full year of membership for permanent membership status, and whose applications are accompanied by payment, according to the following schedule. Life Members are relieved from paying further annual dues, but must pay any magazine mailing charges above bulk mail, if the Life Member desires such mailing enhancement:

Age 25-39: then-current dues times 25

Age 40-55: then-current dues times 20

Age 55+: then-current dues times 15

After 10 years of continuous completed membership the following rates would apply:

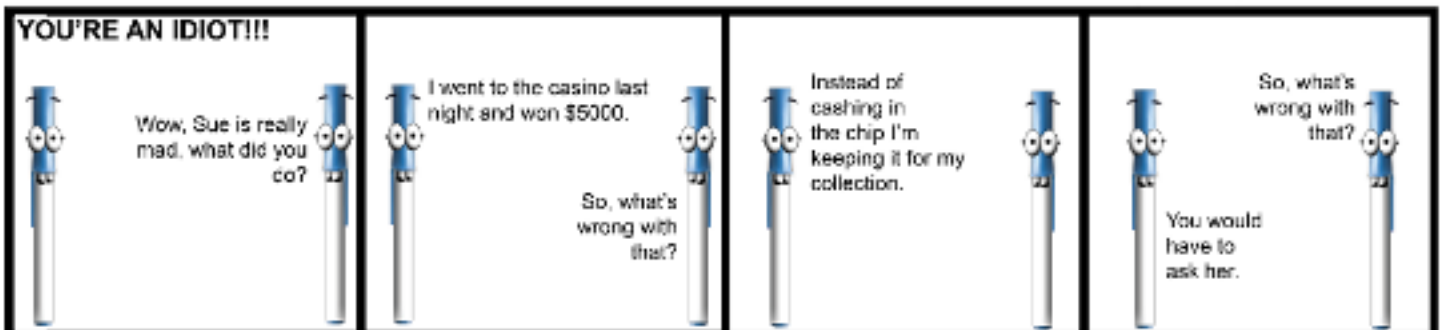
Age 56-75: then-current dues times 10

Age 76+: then-current dues times 5;

E (i). Dues Changes Impacting Life Members: if the Board of Directors raises the organization's annual general membership dues, thus impacting the Life Membership cost to someone who at that time has been a member for less than three years, the Board of Directors may, in its discretion, grandfather in all those members who have been members for less than three (3) years, so that those members, once they have completed their third year, may become life members by paying the multiplier times the annual dues in effect when they first became a regular member. The member must pay the increased annual dues until the completion of the third year. At the completion of the third year, the member has a one-time only, two month window to apply for Life Membership at the grandfathered lower rate.

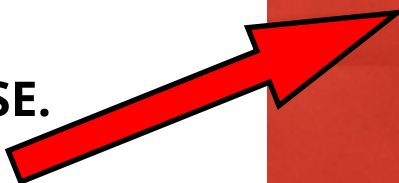

Up until then, casinos were unregulated and were known to cheat their customers, keeping away the serious gamblers while fleecing the tourists. Lansky cleaned up the casinos and on his way to fulfill Batista's dream until Fidel Castro overthrew the corrupt regime. This seminar looks at the history of Cuban casinos, those who ran the casinos and the casino collectibles from that era. Charles Kaplan, MoGH Chairman (acting) will present.

Here's a little background on these two accomplished ladies:



**Linda Johnson** - Nicknamed the "First Lady of Poker", Linda Johnson is a bracelet winning poker professional and a big part of the explosion in the popularity of the game. She is the recipient of Poker's highest honors, being elected to the Poker Hall of Fame and the Women in Poker Hall of Fame. Johnson was one of the founders of the World Poker Tour (WPT) and was the announcer to the studio audience for its first six seasons. In 2017, the World Poker Tour awarded her with the first WPT Honors Award. Johnson set up the Tournament Directors Association (TDA), which sets common rules for tournaments. She also helped found

PokerGives.org, a nonprofit organization that makes it easier for poker players to donate to charity. She was the publisher/editor of Card Player Magazine in the early years of the publication, and is currently co-owner of Card Player Cruises, where she has hosted more than 150 poker cruises.

**Jan Fisher** - Jan cut her teeth in poker as a poker dealer in Las Vegas for 15 years before moving on to semi-professional playing and poker management, and has been inducted into the Women in Poker Hall of Fame. She hosts and directs the semi-annual Eureka Open poker tournament in Mesquite, Nevada, and has served as the tournament director for the highly successful PartyPoker.com Million events. Fisher is a founder of the Tournament Directors Association and is a past member of the Board of Directors for the Poker Players Alliance. She gives poker seminars and lessons around the country, and her magazine column entitled "Fishing Around" is a must-read in the poker community. Fisher is a partner in Card Player Cruises.
