The 31<sup>st</sup> Annual Casino Collectibles Exhibit and Show Returns to Las Vegas in June 13-15 at the South Point Casino





Thursday thru Saturday, June 13 - 15, 2024. It is the World's Largest Casino Chip and Collectibles

Registered show attendees can also take in the four planned educational seminars or participate in a live auction of hundreds of casino chips and other casino memorabilia.

The Casino Chips and Collectibles Show registration and admission is open to the public June 13, 10 AM – 5 PM (admission \$10), June 15, 9 AM – 4 PM (admission \$5) and June 17, 9 AM – 4 PM (admission is free).
